Scholarships and Subsidies Terms and Conditions

NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarships

1. NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarship applications close as follows:
 - a. July 2017 intake – 5pm Friday 30th June 2017
2. The 32-week part-time programme is the Postgraduate Certificate in Applied Practice (Digital and Collaborative Learning).
3. NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarships are \$2000 + GST each as a partial waiver of student tuition fees for the programme. Therefore, the total balance of fees payable for domestic students will be \$750 + GST per student.
4. An applicant must be a registered teacher and employed at a registered New Zealand public (state or state integrated) Primary, Intermediate or Secondary school (or have received a confirmed offer of employment at such a school).
5. By receiving a NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarship, each recipient agrees to participate in an evaluation (research) project.
6. Recipients must meet programme eligibility criteria and complete enrolment (including providing supporting documents and meeting any offer conditions) by:
 - a. July 2017 intake – 5pm Friday 7th July 2017
7. Recipients must complete the programme to the satisfaction of The Mind Lab by Unitec. Failure to do so will entitle The Mind Lab by Unitec to require the recipient to pay the reimbursement of NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarship of \$2000 + GST.
8. If you are a NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarship recipient and withdraw within the 10% from the start of the programme, you will be liable for 10% of your fee or receive a 90% refund. If you withdraw more than 10% after the start of the programme, you will be liable for 100% of your fee or will not receive a refund.
9. NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarships will be allocated on a 'first in, first served' basis for each region. 'First-in, first served' will be based on the completion of enrolment.
10. We have a limited number of NEXT Generation Teacher scholarships available nationwide for the July 2017 intake only.
11. A maximum of 4 NEXT Generation Teacher scholarships may be permitted per registered public school.
12. NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarship allocations are subject to change. A final decision on allocations is at the sole discretion of The Mind Lab by Unitec.
13. NEXT Generation Teacher Scholarships may not be used in conjunction with any other Unitec scholarship e.g. early-bird discount.



14. Recipients from selected Gisborne public schools may be eligible for a further \$375 + GST discount due to the generous support of Activate Tairāwhiti and Eastland Community Trust. This discount will be allocated at the sole discretion of The Mind Lab by Unitec.
15. Recipients from selected Rotorua public schools may be eligible for a further \$650 + GST discount due to the generous support of Nga Pumanawa e Waru. This discount will be allocated at the sole discretion of The Mind Lab by Unitec.
16. Recipients from approved schools within Lower Hutt may also be eligible for a further \$650 + GST discount due to the generous support of Hutt Science (a Hutt City Council initiative). This discount will be allocated at the sole discretion of The Mind Lab by Unitec.
17. Recipients from selected schools within other regions may also be eligible for a further \$750 + GST discount. This discount will be allocated at the sole discretion of The Mind Lab by Unitec.

Early-bird Offer

1. Early-bird offer close as follows:
 - a. July 2017 intake – 5pm Friday 23rd June 2017
2. The 32-week part-time programme is the Postgraduate Certificate in Applied Practice (Digital and Collaborative Learning).
3. Early-bird offer is a 15% discount on total tuition fee of \$2750 + GST. Therefore, total payable is \$2337.50 + GST per student.
4. The early-bird discount will only be allocated to recipients who meet programme eligibility criteria and complete enrolment (including providing supporting documents and meeting any offer conditions) by:
 - a. July 2017 intake – 5pm Friday 7th July 2017
5. This offer cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer ie: NEXT Generation Teacher scholarship.
6. A final decision on early-bird discount allocations is at the sole discretion of The Mind Lab by Unitec.



Competition offer for Professional Development or School Group Visit

1. The Professional Development or School Group Visit competition offer is valid from 12th May 2017 - 7th July 2017.
2. The prize must be redeemed by 15th December 2017.
3. This offer enters into a prize draw every educator that fully enrolls in the July 2017 intake of the Postgraduate Certificate of Applied Practice (Digital and Collaborative Learning) providing enrollment is completed by 5:00pm, 7th July 2017.
4. Fully enrolled means that you have applied for the programme, submitted all documentation, accepted your offer and are fully enrolled in the Unitec system.
5. The winner may select **one** prize from the three following options:
 - A two hour Professional Development session worth \$950+GST for up to 16 teachers in one of our physical labs
 - A two hour school group visit worth \$720+GST for up to 60 students in our Auckland Newmarket lab
 - 2 x two hour school group visits worth \$720+GST for 30 students per visit in our Christchurch, Gisborne or Wellington labs
6. School group visits must be booked during term time and will be subject to availability.
7. The Professional Development session will need to take place after Week 5 of the July 2017 intake.
8. School group visits are for children Year 1-13. This option is therefore unavailable to Early Childhood or Tertiary educators.
9. Additional teachers may attend the Professional Development session at a cost of \$60+GST per person if arranged in advance.
10. Transport to and from the labs is not included.
